



Illegal Material Notice & Policy

Lifeline Voice and Data will never intentionally search through personal data of any client. Lifeline Voice and Data believe all persons are Constitutionally allowed to exercise their freedom of Speech, ideas, and pursue any research of their choosing. However, under Tennessee State Law, Lifeline Voice and Data must report Four Specific Exceptions. Please take note of the Following specified Exceptions Below:

Lifeline Voice and Data will Report to local authorities the following activities:

1. Evidence of Possession, Receiving or Distribution, of Child Pornography.
2. Evidence of an imminent threat or plan of imminent threat of serious bodily injury or death against another person(s).
3. Evidence of Child Abuse or Child Endangerment.
4. Evidence of Terrorist activities in the nature of inflicting harm/death to citizens of The United States of America.

In the course of work, repair or diagnostics if we find illegal material such as child pornography, threats or material relating to the threat of someone's life or any other material deemed illegal we will and are required to report these items to the local authorities.

***Lifeline Voice and Data do not judge or inhibit anyone's habits, likes, dislikes, freedom of speech or the exercise of the freedom of ideas.**

Examples:

The possession of pornography is **NOT** illegal. The possession of **CHILD** pornography **IS** illegal.

The possession of survival documents, other books and materials relating to the subject, are **NOT** illegal. The possession of a plan to harm someone or commit an act of terrorism **IS** illegal.
